WHAT IS CALVARY KIDS?

Our Children's Ministry is designed for kids to learn Biblical truths in safe, fun, and developmentally appropriate classes. Each week, children in Calvary Kids engage in worship and lessons tailored to their grade level, including Bible stories, games, crafts, and other activities. All Children's Ministry teammates are continually trained and have passed a full background check.



WHAT ABOUT ATTENDING CHURCH TOGETHER?

The adult service is intended to be a spiritually academic setting environment where messages are relevant to everyday life and all adults can grow in their faith. Because we cover all subjects the Bible presents, including complex topics like sexuality, violence, and struggle with sin, our adult service is a PG-13 environment. This is one of the reasons we expend tremendous effort to make the children's classrooms age-appropriate, engaging, and safe environments so that coming to Calvary will be a great experience for your whole family.

WHAT IF CALVARY KIDS IS NOT YET RIGHT FOR MY CHILD?

While we believe Calvary Kids is the best place for your children to learn and enjoy church at Calvary, we have created a family section in the Adult Service for newborn babies, kids in transition, and visitors. Out of consideration for others, we ask you to please exit quietly if your child starts crying or making noise. The Family Area outside the auditorium is a more flexible environment where you can continue watching a live broadcast of the church service. This area offers a changing station, coloring area, and toys.
